AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE

A CONTRACT AND SUBSEQUENT RENEWALS WITH ST. LOUIS
COLLEGE OF PHARMACY FOR SERVICES OF A
LICENSED CLINICAL PHARMACIST FOR THE
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY,
MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County Executive on behalf of St. Louis County, Missouri, is authorized to execute a contract with St. Louis College of Pharmacy College ("College") for the services of a licensed clinical pharmacist.

SECTION 2. The contract authorized in Section 1 shall provide for College to provide a licensed clinical pharmacist to work collaboratively with the Department of Health, to instruct and supervise pharmacy students and residents, and to provide drug education to Department of Health patients and health care providers; for a term from January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005; for payment by St. Louis County to College in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) annually; and for such other terms and conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.

SECTION 3. The County Executive is authorized to execute annual renewals of the contract authorized in Section 1, provided that any such renewal shall be upon the same terms and conditions as the original.

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH ST. LOUIS COLLEGE OF PHARMACY FOR SERVICES OF A LICENSED CLINICAL PHARMACIST FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County Executive on behalf of St. Louis County, Missouri, is authorized to execute a contract with St. Louis College of Pharmacy College for the services of a licensed clinical pharmacist.

SECTION 2. The contract authorized in Section 1 shall provide for College to provide a licensed clinical pharmacist to work collaboratively with the Department of Health; instruct and supervise pharmacy students and residents; and provide drug education to Department of Health patients and health care providers; for a term of one year from August 1, 2000 through July 31, 2001; for payment by St. Louis County to College in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) annually; for three subsequent automatic renewals for additional one-year terms at a rate not to exceed (\$35,000.00) annually; and for such other terms and conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.

ORDINANCE NO. 18,892, 1998

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ON BEHALF OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, TO ENTER INTO AN AFFILIATION AGREEMENT WITH THE ST. LOUIS COLLEGE OF PHARMACY FOR THE PROVISION OF PHARMACOLOGICAL CARE TO PATIENTS IN THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S COMMUNITY SERVICES AND HEALTH CENTERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County Executive on behalf of St. Louis County, Missouri, is authorized to enter into an affiliation agreement with the St. Louis College of Pharmacy for the provision of pharmacological care to patients in the St. Louis County Department of Health's community services and health centers.

SECTION 2. The agreement authorized in Section 1 shall provide for the St. Louis College of Pharmacy to furnish a clinical pharmacist to work collaboratively with the Department of Health, to instruct and supervise pharmacy students and residents, and to provide education to patients and drug education to staff and health care providers; for a one-year renewable term beginning August 1, 1998; and for such other terms and conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.
