AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH RPH ON THE GO USA, INC., FOR TEMPORARY PHARMACIST AND PHARMACIST-IN-CHARGE/MANAGER-IN-CHARGE SERVICES AT THE JOHN C. MURPHY HEALTH CENTER; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County Executive on behalf of St. Louis County, Missouri, is authorized to execute a contract with RPH on the Go USA, Inc. ("RPH"), for temporary pharmacist and pharmacist-in-charge/manager-in-charge services at the John C. Murphy Health Center, to cover the period from March 1 to April 30, 2003.

SECTION 2. The contract authorized in Section 3 shall provide for RPH to provide the services of a pharmacist-in-charge/manager-in-charge for up to forty-five (45) hours per week at the rate of Seventy-Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$73.80) per hour and the services of one or more pharmacists for a total of up to ninety hours (90) per week at the rate of Sixty-Three Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$63.80) per hour, with maximum payment under the contract not to exceed Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00); and for such other terms and conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.

SECTION 3. The immediate and ongoing placement of personnel to staff the pharmacy at the John C. Murphy Health Center is necessary to protect the public health, and this ordinance therefore addresses a public emergency affecting the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare and shall become effective immediately upon its enactment after a two-thirds majority vote hereon by the County Council.

July 1, 2003 and ending June 30, 2004; for payment in an amount
not to exceed Five Million Nine Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand
Dollars (\$5,923,000.00) per year; for up to three one-year
renewals upon the same terms; and for such other terms and
conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.

SECTION 3. The County Executive, on behalf of St. Louis
County, is authorized to execute a contract and up to three
subsequent renewals with Interlock Pharmacy Systems, Inc., for
pharmacy services for the corrections pharmacy needs of the
Department of Health.

SECTION 4. The contract authorized in Section 1 shall
provide for Interlock Pharmacy Systems, Inc., to provide
corrections pharmacy services for the Department of Health; for
a one-year contract beginning July 1, 2003 and ending June 30,

2004; for payment in an amount not to exceed One Million Eighty-One Thousand Dollars (\$1,081,000.00) per year; for up to three one-year renewals upon the same terms; and for such other terms and conditions as are approved by the County Counselor.
