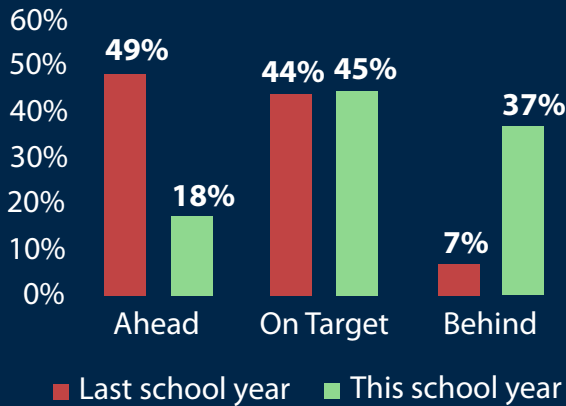
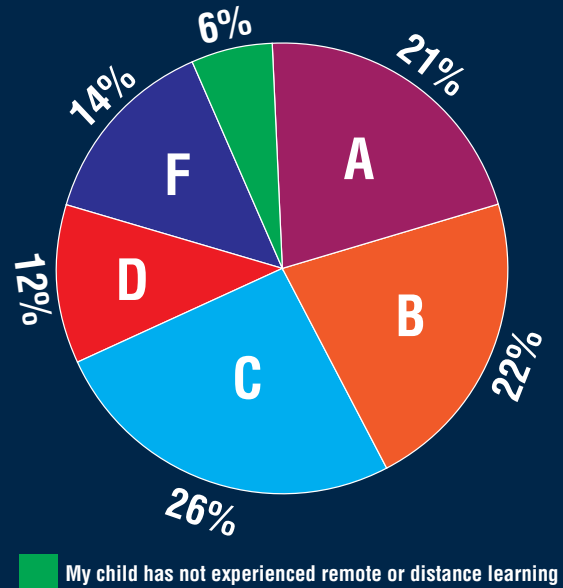


WHAT MISSOURIANS THINK ABOUT THE 2020–21 SCHOOL YEAR

Only 40% of parents give their child's remote learning experience an A or B rating.

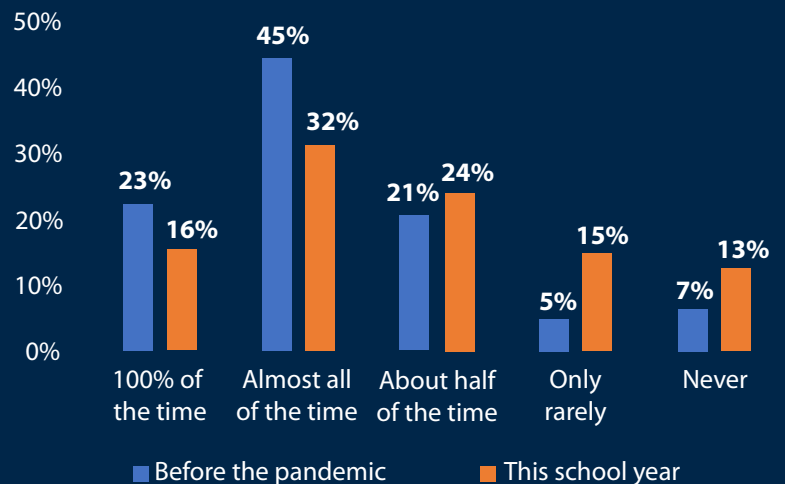


52 percent

Results for this poll are based on automated telephone interviews conducted among a statewide sample of 510 likely voters with school-aged children. Data for this survey research was collected by Cor Services Inc. The surveys were conducted December 2-10, 2020.
